We have proudly founded the first ever intergenerational guaranteed income project for students and families in Washington, D.C.!

WHAT IS "GUARANTEED INCOME?"

You've may have heard of basic income. This is similar.

"Guaranteed income refers to a regular cash payment accessible to certain members of a community, with no strings attached (ie, unconditional). Guaranteed income redistributes wealth to people who need it most and who've historically been impacted by lack of opportunities—largely people of color."



PROGRAM DETAILS

Guaranteed, Together is a program that gives both direct cash benefits and legal education services. In the past, participating households received \$800 a month, distributed weekly, for three months. From our pilot in Summer/Fall 2024, 100% of families reported being able to meet their basic needs while in the program.

WHO QUALIFIES? HOW TO GET INVOLVED?

To participate, families must be enrolled at SJS and meet certain socioeconomic factors, such as residing in areas east of the Anacostia River (i.e., Wards 5, 6, 7, 8)—communities that have historically been impacted by adverse social determinants of health.
